### 1. Relax on South Beach

One of the most famous beaches in the world, South Beach is a great place to spend the afternoon sunbathing. Make sure you check out the brightly colored lifeguard stands!



### 2. Check out the art deco architecture

It can be easy to miss the pastel colored art deco buildings littered along Ocean Drive. For a better view of these famous buildings, walk along the walkway closest to the beach!

### 3. Visit Wynwood Walls

### 4. Visit Little Havana

If you're in South Beach, it's worth checking out the Wolfsonian Museum (entry is \$10 or \$5 for students). Art lovers should visit Miami's Perez Art Museum (\$16 or \$12 for students)
